The SCI staff established the following goals for 2016/2017...

- All students will have increased their basic math skills, mental math strategies and be able to relate math to the real world.
- * We implemented a grade 9 Transitional Math course that was able to get grade 9 students engaged in math and at the same time improve their math skills, including mental math strategies.
- * Math teachers attended various professional development sessions that focused on improving math skills, mental strategies and engagement in math students in math.

- 2. Teachers will use at least two restitution strategies in classes to help develop positive, respectful learning relationships.
- Discussed and role played ways to use restitution during professional development days.
- * Staff members shared their restitution experiences and stories during staff meetings and professional development days.
- * Administration worked with students and staff to model restitution strategies with students.
- * Staff continued to use their restitution resources
- * Continued to improve the restitution form for students in difficulty
- 3. Teachers will use at least two technology programs to engage students in their classes.
- * Teachers attended professional development opportunities to help incorporate technology into classes.
- * Purchased technology programs for teachers to use in classes that helped students relate course material to real-life situations much better than text books (simulation activities, etc.).
- Trained students and staff on Office 365 to use as a collaboration tool.
- Purchased a laptop cart that greatly increased technology use around the school and gave the ability to teachers to use various technology programs in their classes.
