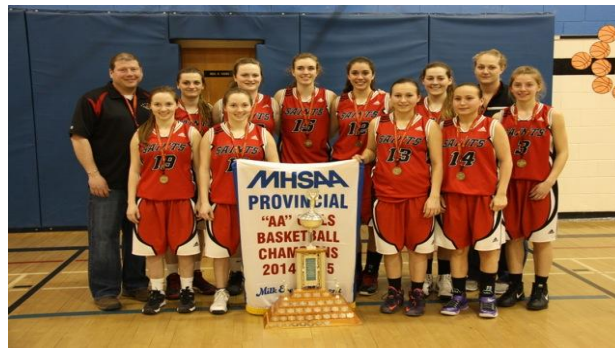

2014-2015 School Priorities

TELL THEM FROM ME – All TCI students this year participated in a survey which provided valuable information on social-emotional and academic outcomes. Our student outcomes were then compared to national norms. As a staff we looked at the data from the October and May TTFM surveys and this helped us create some programming that would be the most beneficial to our students at TCI.

Our school plan for this year and moving forward is focused on three main priority areas:

- 1) ***Student Achievement: “Raising the Bar”*** – focusing on student achievement on year end grades – getting students, parents and staff believing that 50% is not “good enough” by 2018.
- 2) ***To establish a Positive School Climate at TCI:*** Reducing the incidents of reported bullying each year to the point where by June 2018 TCI can report no incidents of bullying.
- 3) ***Sustainable Development:*** Reducing the student/staff/school carbon foot print through reduction in use of hydro, water, paper and ink.

2014-2015 Highlights

Here is a brief summary of some of the activities that went on at TCI this year.

- With the help of the Teulon Lion’s, TCI was able to purchase a digital sign. The sign has been used for community events as well as school events.
- The Arts_– Band concerts/camp, Visual Arts displays , Drama performances
- TCI Girls Group, Green Team , Helping Hands, Circle of Friends, Yearbook, and numerous field trips.
- Athletics - TCI hosted a “Softball for Kidsport” tournament with 20 co-ed teams throughout the Interlake participating. We had one of TCI’s most successful sporting years in the history of TCI. Three teams each won a Provincial Championship. JVB Volleyball, Varsity Girls Basketball, and Varsity Badminton. Mr. Darragh and Mrs. Tataryn were named “Global Coaches of the Month” (March 2015). An interview with the coaches and Varsity Girls Basketball team was aired on Global on March 30th. The coaches were also named “Payworks Coaches of the Month” by MHSAA for April 2015. For the first time TCI had a Lacrosse Team which played in the High School Lacrosse League during the months of May and June.
- Town Clean-up by all students and staff done on May 20/15.
- Outdoor Education Canoe trip from May 25 – May 27, 2015.
- Outdoor Survivor Camp trip from May 24 – May 27, 2015.
- Arbor Day – Tree Planting Ceremony at TCI on May 29/15.

◦ This year's Youth in Philanthropy group raised over \$1100 in funds that goes back into the Teulon community in the form of community grants for worthwhile projects and purchases.

Examples of previous recipients of YIP grants:

- Library: book collections, new chairs
- Teulon Elementary School: a new document projector
- Teulon Daycare: sand play table, a new fence

YIP ran a hot beverage sale at lunch once a week throughout the year, a bake sale, a pizza sale, and their annual Carnival Day at Teulon Elementary School on June 24. This has been the most successful fundraising year for the Teulon Collegiate YIP group so far!

TCI's class of 2015 was very successful with 38 graduates in all, 6 gold medals handed out for averages of 90% or higher and a total of just under \$60 000 was presented at Grad to 13 different graduates. Great work everyone!!

We would like to wish Felix Lesiuk a happy retirement, who after 28 ½ years is leaving us to chase down trains all over the Prairies . Mr. Lesiuk taught 7 years at WCI and 21 ½ years at TCI.
