Community Report 2015-2016





2015-2016 School Priorities

TELL THEM FROM ME – All TCI students this year participated in a survey which provided valuable information on social-emotional and academic outcomes. Our student outcomes were then compared to national norms. As a staff we looked at the data from the October and May TTFM surveys and this helped us create some programming that would be the most beneficial to our students at TCI.

Our school plan for this year and moving forward is focused on these main priority areas:

- 1) *Student Achievement: “Raising the Bar”* – focusing on student achievement on year end grades. Changing the belief of some students that 50% is “good enough”. Therefore by 2018 all students will have a mark of 70% or better. Data sources in April indicated that 81% of students had an average of 70% or better. Using data sources such as Provincial Assessments, PowerSchool, and the RAD, teacher are able to determine how to set up a class profile so they can best support each student that is in their classes. To improve intellectual engagement our 7 and 8 teachers have been working closely with Divisional Lead Teachers, as well TCI implemented a very successful reading recovery program in the second semester which the data showed us that these students improved their reading by 1 to 2 grade levels. Numeracy is an area that as a school we want to continue to implement changes that we feel will improve the understanding and knowledge students have of numeracy before they leave TCI. To start we have increased the students contact time in mathematics classes. As a staff we looked at the use of numeracy throughout our courses and how to help all students have a good foundation and understanding of numeracy before they graduate. We are celebrating student successes in the classroom through reintroducing our honor role.**
- 2) *To establish a Positive School Climate at TCI:* Reducing the incidents of reported bullying each year to the point where by June 2018 TCI can report no incidents of bullying. Through the TTFM survey students have reported that the incidence of bullying have decreased each school year over the last 4 years. TCI has adopted the Restitution Model**

for discipline. Our staff has outlined to students our school beliefs and bottom lines. These have been discussed with students and posted throughout the building. TCI hosted a Parent Meeting on April 20th where Administration, Trustees and Parents were in attendance. Data from this meeting was shared with staff. The Kandu Café has provided a great opportunity for some of our students to learn valuable work experience. It has definitely added to creating a positive school climate here at TCI.

- 3) ***Sustainable Development:*** Reducing the student/staff/school carbon foot print through reduction in use of hydro, water, paper and ink. By looking at different data sources both divisionally and school based the staff and students of TCI have been working on sustainability. TCI has continued to recycle, compost, grow vegetables in the Greenhouse etc... and are planning to institute more green projects in the future.
- 4) Building relationships with students is a clear indicator of student success. This year 71% of students reported on the Tell Them for Me Survey that they felt that they had a “go to” adult here at TCI. Our goal is to increase that perception so that by 2018, 100% of students feel that they have an adult that they can “go to”.

2015-2016 Highlights

Here is a brief summary of some of the activities that went on at TCI this year.

- The Arts – Band concerts/camp, Visual Arts displays , Ms. Bilenki’s Drama class performance of Peter Pan (March 22 and 23)
- TCI Girls Group, Crochet Club, Green Team, Helping Hands, Circle of Friends, Yearbook, and numerous fieldtrips. TCI students went to WE Day November 16th.
- Kandu Café opened at TCI to provide work experience and delicious food to our students and staff.
- TCI Greenhouse – providing work experience for our students and growing produce to use at Kandu Cafe.
- TCI Voluntour Trip to Dominican Republic (Mrs. Philippot and Mrs. Bawdon)
- Athletics - TCI hosted a “Softball for Kidsport” tournament with 20 co-ed teams throughout the Interlake participating. JHG Volleyball Team won Divisional Championship. JHG Basketball Team won Divisional Championship. Varsity Badminton won a Provincial Championship for the second year in a row. Mr. Darragh and Mrs. Tataryn were awarded the Peter Dick Award at the Coaching Manitoba Impact

Awards. Mr. Ledochowski was named "Payworks Coach of the Month" by MHSAA for April 2016.

- **Town Clean-up by all students and staff done on May 24/16.**
- **Outdoor Education Canoe trip from May 30 – June 1, 2016.**
- **Outdoor Survivor Camp trip from May 29 – June 1, 2016.**
- **This year's Youth in Philanthropy group raised funds that goes back into the Teulon community in the form of community grants for worthwhile projects and purchases.**

Examples of previous recipients of YIP grants:

- **Library: book collections, new chairs, board games**
- **Teulon Elementary School: a new document projector**
- **Teulon Daycare: sand play table, a new fence, play structure**
- **Green Acres Art Centre: sound system**

TCI's class of 2016 was very successful with 27 graduates in all, 6 gold medals handed out for averages of 90% or higher and a total of just under \$20 000 was presented at Grad to 6 different graduates. Great work everyone!!
