- Through a “My Voice” initiative 6K students wrote books for Kathy Knowles library in Ghana, Africa.
- These early literacy books on “Winter in Manitoba” will be placed in one of Kathy’s libraries in Accra , Ghana.
- Teulon Elementary hopes to maintain a sustainable partnership that continues to develop literacy awareness as well as share our culture on a global level.
- This spring, TES students and their teachers were invited to share their literacy project at Kathy Knowle’s fundraiser in Winnipeg, her home town.
